Reposition the wood and furniture sector as an eco-friendly, smart, quality of life assisting and knowledge intensive sector.

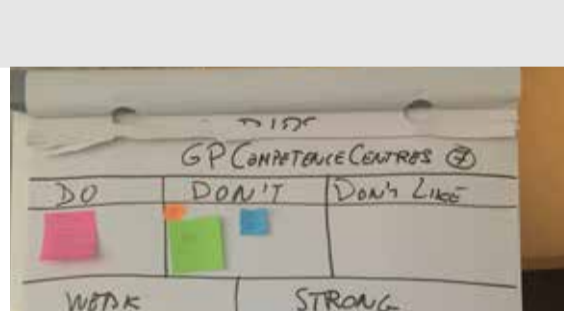
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8. Industry-led Competence Centres and the CREST report
